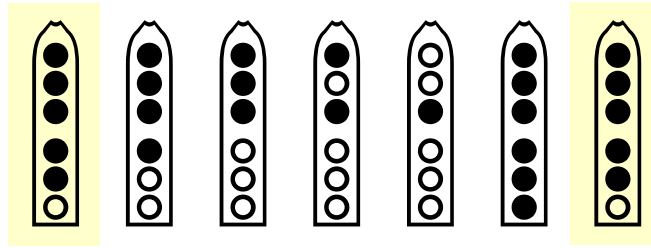

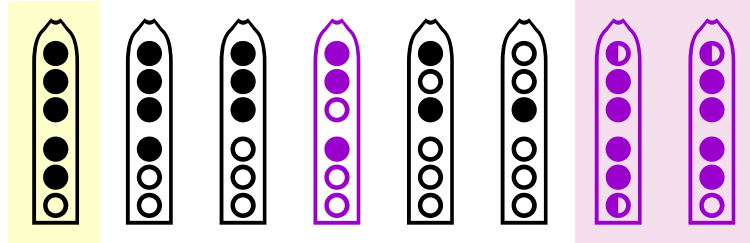

The Major / Diatonic Scale

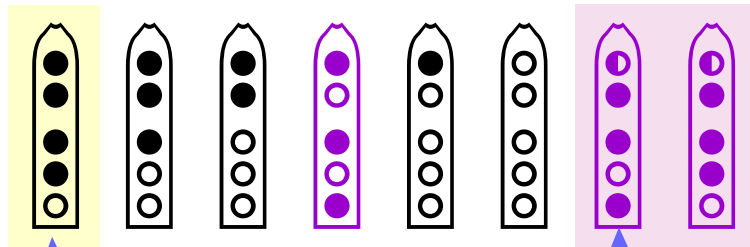
The basic notes in the major / diatonic scale:

The major / diatonic scale on a five-hole Native Flute, with additional notes:



Notes in yellow shading are the "tonal center" of this scale.

Notes in pink shading are in the upper register. They are challenging to play, often sound strained, and will not play on many Native Flutes.

A flute in the key of ____ plays in the relative major key of ____ with the scale shown above.

A minor	...	C major
Bb minor	...	C# (Db) major
B minor	...	D major
C minor	...	D# (Eb) major
C# (Db) minor	...	E major
D minor	...	F major
D# (Eb) minor	...	F# (Gb) major
E minor	...	G major
F minor	...	G# (Ab) major
F# (Gb) minor	...	A major
G minor	...	Bb major
G# (Ab) minor	...	B major
